Biblical Implications The Creator is the world's only God.

The Creator is King

The Creator-God created all nations.

He is our Father of all nations.


God's human family consists of all nations

He provides all of our needs.

He determines how the world works.

God gives life and honor. Therefore, human death and shame are not God's desire.

The Creator-God deserves all praise, loyalty, and love.



All other so-called "gods" are false gods

We must not worship created things, i.e. idols.

When people worship these so-called "gods", they worship demons (not true gods)

Created things (like demons, spirits) have limited power.

God can overcome evil in his creation.

God wants the entire world to be His sacred space, His "Temple."

All nations are equal before God.

All humans should be humble.

Sin disrupts harmony and relationships in the world.

"In people's worldview, what is the assumed problem with the world?"

Our pure manner of life should reflect God's presence

John 9:1-10:5

²⁰ His parents answered, "We know that this is our son and that he was born blind. ²¹ But how he now sees we do not know, nor do we know who opened his eyes. Ask him; he is of age. He will speak for himself." ²² (His parents said these things because they feared the Jews, for the Jews had already agreed that if anyone should confess Jesus to be Christ, he was to be **put out of the synagogue**.) ²³ Therefore his parents said, "He is of age; ask him."

John 9:1-10:5

9:34 They answered him, "You were born in utter sin, and would you teach us?" And they cast him out.

^{10:2} But he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. ³ To him the gatekeeper opens. The sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. ⁴ When he has **brought out all his own**, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. ⁵ A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers."

John 6, 12

^{6:37} All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out.

^{12:31} Now is the judgment of this world; now will the ruler of this world be **cast out**. ³² And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself." ³³ He said this to show by what kind of death he was going to die.

^{12:42} Nevertheless, many even of the authorities believed in him, but for fear of the Pharisees they did not confess it, so that they would not be **put out of the synagogue**; ⁴³ for they loved the glory that comes from man more than the glory that comes from God.

John 16:2

^{16:1} "I have said all these things to you to keep you from falling away. ² They will **put you out of the synagogues**. Indeed, the hour is coming when whoever kills you will think he is offering service to God.
