# **ASIAN CHURCH HISTORY**

#### A. Scope of the Course

The history of Christianity in Asia is as old as the history of Christianity itself. But while much has been told about Christianity as it went west from Jerusalem to Antioch and then to Ephesus, Rome and the Western world, not enough has been told about how Christianity went east from Jerusalem to Antioch and then to Edessa, to Ctesiphon, to Madras, India, to Nishipur, Iran, to Merv, Turkmenistan, to Heart, Afghanistan, to Karakorum, Mongolia, to Beijing, China and to hundreds of towns and cities in between and especially along the Silk Road throughout the first 1000 years of church history. The purpose of this course is to introduce students to this "missing half" of church history and how Christianity came to Asia.

#### **B.** Purpose

Word of Life Bible Institute seeks to equip its students with the ability to live lives of maximum effectiveness and influence for the Lord. A practical, working knowledge of how Christians have done this in the history of the Asian church is very helpful in accomplishing that objective.

C. Course Goals: In exams and assignments, students will be expected to...

- 1. Locate key cities and towns in Asian church history and understand their significance.
- 2. Understand how the 1907 Korean Revival happened.
- 3. Identify the reasons Asian Christianity rose and fell from AD 100-1500.
- 4. Identify key leaders in Asian Church History.

#### D. Procedures/Assignments for the Course

1. Read the assigned section of <i>The Korean Pentecost</i> (48 pages).	25 Points
2. Complete a map of Asia marking key cities in Asian Church History.	5 Points
3. Maintain a journal of 10 insights learned in class and 5 insights learned from reading	15 Points
4. Statistical Information on Asian Countries	5 Points
5. Answer three quizzes (10 questions each) and one final exam (20 questions)	50 Points
