






Islam: "God revealed himself to Muhammad. Allah has no son. Islam needs no savior. Jesus lived, but I reject that Jesus claimed to be God, died on a cross, or rose from the dead. Allah wills us to make the entire world submit to him, by force if necessary."

Biblical Christianity: "God revealed Himself to Moses and the prophets and I believe that the true historical Jesus was the promised Messiah. He is my Lord and Savior. Jesus alone lived a sinless life, performed a ministry of miracles, fullfilled all the first advent Messianic prophecies, died on the cross to pay the full penalty for our sins, and three days later rose from the dead, exactly as He said He would!"

Judaism: "God revealed Himself to Moses and the prophets, but I reject the historical Jesus as being the promised Messiah." The bones of Muhammad are still in Medina, the bones of Confucius are still in Shantung, the cremated bones of Buddha are still in Nepal, the bones of Joseph Smith are still in Nauvoo, Illinois, and the cremated bones of L. Ron. Hubbard are still (somewhere) in the Pacific Ocean. But, Jesus' tomb IS empty. Even the 1st century jews who handed Jesus over to be crucified never denied this fact!

They produce a fictitious history of this kind, which they style the Gospel of Judas."



"Matthew also issued a written Gospel among the Hebrews in their own dialect, while Peter and Paul were preaching at Rome, and laying the foundations of the Church. After their departure, Mark, the disciple and interpreter of Peter, did also hand down to us in writing what had been preached by Peter. Luke also, the companion of Paul, recorded in a book the Gospel preached by him. Afterwards, John, the disciple of the Lord, who also had leaned upon His breast, did himself publish a Gospel during his residence at Ephesus in Asia."

- Written by Apostle (or under an Apostle)
- Widely Accepted (used by churches)
- Theologically Sound (no false doctrine)

None of these applied to the books Dan Brown says were the "real Scripture," such as the *Gospel of Philip & Gospel of Thomas*


#### The Arian Controversy and Trinitarianism<sup>8</sup>







Those who denied that they were or had been Christians, when they invoked the gods in words dictated by me, offered prayer with incense and wine to your image, which I had ordered to be brought for this purpose together with statues of the gods, and moreover cursed **Christ—none of which those who** are really Christians, it is said, can be forced to do—these I thought should be discharged.

## Early Church Suffering

Emperor Trajan to Governor Pliny (AD 111):

You observed proper procedure, my dear Pliny, in sifting the cases of those who had been denounced to you as Christians... They are not to be sought out... Whoever denies that he is a Christian and really proves it—that is, by worshipping our gods—even though he was under suspicion in the past, shall obtain pardon through repentance..."





## Significance of Josephus



Earliest non-Christian witness to the historicity of Jesus Christ (AD 93-94)

## Short quote by Josephus

"Convening the judges of the Sanhedrin, he [Ananus, son of Annas] brought before them a man named James, the brother of Jesus who was called the Christ, and certain others. He accused them of having transgressed the law, and condemned them to be stoned to death"

(Ant. 20.9.1 in Maier, 276; cf. Whiston, 4:140).

Josephus inaccurately refers to James as the brother of Jesus (cf. Acts 12:1-2; AD 44).

## Long quote (two versions)



#### Jewish

"At this time there was a wise man called Jesus, and his conduct was good, and he was known to be virtuous. Many people among the Jews and the other nations became his disciples. Pilate condemned him to be crucified and to die. But those who had become his disciples did not abandon his discipleship. They reported that he appeared to them three days after his crucifixion and that he was alive. Accordingly, he was perhaps the Messiah, concerning whom the prophets have reported wonders. And the tribe of the Christians, so named after him, has not disappeared to this day."

#### Christian

"About this time lived Jesus, a wise man, if indeed one ought to call him a man. For he was the achiever of extraordinary deeds and was a teacher of those who accept the truth gladly. He won over many Jews and many of the Greeks. He was the Messiah. When he was indicted by the principal men among us and Pilate condemned him to be crucified, those who had come to love him originally did not cease to do so; for he appeared to them on the third day restored to life, as the prophets of the Deity had foretold these and countless other marvelous things about him. And the tribe of Christians, so named after him, has not disappeared to this day."
