Luke 3:23: "Now Jesus himself was about 30 years old when He began His ministry. He was the son, so it was thought, of Joseph." (NIV)

"Luke was tracing the line of Mary. Many interpreters [among varied positions...] argue that Luke was giving the genealogy of Mary, showing that she also was in the line of David and that therefore Jesus was qualified as the Messiah, not only through Joseph (since he was the oldest legal heir) but also through Mary."

15 For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant. That those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance

— now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.

¹⁶In the case of a will, it is necessary to prove the death of the one who made it,

¹⁷because a will is in force only when somebody has died; it never takes effect while the one who made it is living.

¹⁸This is why even the first covenant was not put into effect without blood.

¹⁹When Moses had proclaimed every commandment of the law to all the people, he took the blood of calves, together with water, scarlet wool and branches of hyssop, and sprinkled the scroll and all the people.

He said, "This is the blood of the covenant, which God has commanded you to keep."

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²¹In the same way, he sprinkled with the blood both the tabernacle and everything used in its ceremonies.

What do we do with this Jesus?

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"I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: 'I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God.' That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic—on a level with the man who says he is a poached egg—or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God; or else a madman or something worse."


