





2 ways



Is Genesis 1–11 Real History?

- 1. Myths don't teach "deep truths" better than history
- 2. A non-historical approach is very subjective
- 3. They have vital information otherwise not known
- 4. They fit into the book's argument emphasizing election
- 5. Events are presented as historical
- 6. Science confirms the Genesis 1–11 historical record
- 7. Christ affirmed their historicity






- God's sovereignty and desire to share this rule with man (1:26) is totally his choice alone
- The eleven-section structure narrows down the chosen seed with which God can fellowship
- The overall design shifts from God choosing Adam & his seed (1–11) to Abraham & his seed (12–50)
- Repeated election of the younger over the older shows God's choices are superior to man's




How high was the water?






Noah Wasn't Perfect



Genesis 1:26-28





II. Grasp that the King promised you blessings (Gen 12–50).




Key Verse






Christ Descended from Judah


