"Sound the alarm in Jerusalem! Raise the battle cry on my holy mountain! Let everyone tremble in fear because the day of the LORD is upon us" (Joel 2:1 NLT).



"[The day of the LORD]... is a day of darkness and gloom, a day of thick clouds and deep blackness. Suddenly, like dawn spreading across the mountains, a great and mighty army appears. Nothing like it has been seen before or will ever be seen again" (Joel 2:2 NLT).

"Fire burns in front of them, and flames follow after them. Ahead of them the land lies as beautiful as the Garden of Eden. Behind them is nothing but desolation; not one thing escapes" (Joel 2:3 NLT). "They look like horses; they charge forward like war horses" (Joel 2:4 NLT). "Look at them as they leap along the mountaintops. #### Israel's repentance will bring forgiveness, deliverance and restoration (Joel 2:18–3:21).



"Then the LORD will pity his people and jealously guard the honor of his land. <sup>19</sup>The LORD will reply, 'Look! I am sending you grain and new wine and olive oil, enough to satisfy your needs. You will no longer be an object of mockery among the surrounding nations" (Joel 2:18-19 NLT).





"I will drive away these armies from the north. I will send them into the parched wastelands. Those in the front will be driven into the Dead Sea, and those at the rear into the Mediterranean. **Groaned**, wandered, hungry "How the animals moan with hunger! The herds of cattle wander about confused, because they have no pasture. The flocks of sheep and goats bleat in misery" (Joel 1:18 NLT).

"Don't be afraid, you animals of the field, for the wilderness pastures will soon be green" (Joel 2:22a NLT).

#### Fields Contrasts in Joel 2:21-27

#### Barren and unproductive

"It has destroyed my grapevines and ruined my fig trees, stripping their bark and destroying it, leaving the branches white and bare" (Joel 1:7; cf. 1:10-12 NLT).

## Drought (dryness caused fire)

"Even the wild animals cry out to you because the streams have dried up, and fire has consumed the wilderness pastures" (Joel 1:20 NLT).

#### Grain, Wine & Oil in Joel 2:21-27

#### **Ruined and dried**

"The fields are ruined, the land is stripped bare. The grain is destroyed, the grapes have shriveled, and the olive oil is gone" (Joel 1:10 NLT).

#### Will be plentiful

"The threshing floors will again be piled high with grain, and the presses will overflow with new wine and olive oil" (Joel 2:24 NLT).

#### Crop Contrasts in Joel 2:21-27

#### Damaged by locusts

"After the cutting **locusts finished eating** the crops, the swarming locusts took what was **left! After them came** the hopping locusts, and then the stripping locusts, too!" (Joel 1:4 NLT).

#### **Productive**

"The LORD says, 'I will give you back what you lost to the swarming locusts, the hopping locusts, the stripping locusts, and the cutting locusts. It was I who sent this great destroying army against you....' (Joel 2:25-26 NLT).

"This is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel..." (Acts 2:16)

### Joel 2:28-29 in the NT (cf. Acts 2)

Some say this means "All the LORD's people would be prophets" but is this what Joel said?

No, he said only many types of prophets would exist. "And I will cause wonders in the heavens and on the earth—blood and fire and columns of smoke. <sup>31</sup>The sun will become dark, and the moon will turn blood red before that great and terrible day of the LORD arrives."
