Micah has one of the highest foretelling proportions of the prophetic books (70% of the content). It predicts:

• the falls of Samaria and Jerusalem

 the future restoration via a remnant leading into the messianic age

The Prophetic Message

* The prophets were not pushovers. They went against the tide to preach the word of Yahweh to a rebellious nation.

The Prophetic Message

A major concern posed by the prophets was idolatry.

But they also had social and economic concerns.

They spoke pronouncements of judgments to steer the nation away from the curses.

Christ in Micah

- Micah 5:2 is the only OT prophecy that predicts the birthplace of the Messiah as Bethlehem.
- Micah also gives the best descriptions of the righteous reign of Christ over the whole world (2:12-13; 4:1-8; 5:4-5).



"And you, O Bethlehem in the land of Judah, are not least among the ruling cities of Judah, for a ruler will come from you who will be the shepherd for my people Israel" (Micah 5:2 quoted in Matthew 2:6 NLT)
