### Paul overcame his prison hardships because he had the <u>attitude</u> of Christ (1:1-11).

A. Having Christ's attitude helped Paul see himself as a servant of Christ (1:1-2).

> "This letter is from Paul and Timothy, slaves of Christ Jesus" (NLT).

# B. Having Christ's attitude helped Paul to give thanks and pray (1:3-11).

# Paul's Thanksgiving (1:3-8)

### **Paul's Thanks**

<sup>3</sup>Every time I think of you, I give thanks to my God. <sup>4</sup>Whenever I pray, I make my requests for all of you with joy, <sup>5</sup>for you have been my partners in spreading the Good News about Christ from the time you first heard it until now. <sup>6</sup>And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns (Phil. 1:3-6 NLT)

### Paul modeled iov in his prison ministry by having the <u>attitude</u> of Christ (1:12-30).

<sup>12</sup>And I want you to know, my dear brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me here has helped to spread the Good News (1:12 NLT). <sup>13</sup>For everyone here, including the whole palace guard, knows that I am in chains because of Christ. <sup>14</sup>And because of my imprisonment, most of the believers here have gained confidence and boldly speak God's message without fear (1:13-14 NLT).

<sup>15</sup>It's true that some are preaching out of jealousy and rivalry. **But others preach** about Christ with pure motives. <sup>16</sup>They preach because they love me, for they know I have been appointed to defend the Good News (1:15-16 NLT).

<sup>17</sup>Those others do not have pure motives as they preach about Christ. They preach with selfish ambition, not sincerely, intending to make my chains more painful to me. <sup>18</sup>But that doesn't matter. Whether their motives are false or genuine, the message about Christ is being preached either way, so I rejoice (1:17-18a NLT).

### Who was really chained?

#### Paul rejoiced that whether he was executed or released from prison didn't matter since both had their advantages (1:18b-26)!

#### Philippians 2:1-4

Therefore if there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion, make my joy complete by 2 being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose. 3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves; do not merely look out for your own personal 4 interests, but also for the interests of others.

<sup>5</sup>You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. <sup>6</sup>Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. <sup>7</sup>Instead, he gave up his divine privileges [Greek "he emptied himself"]; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human

form, <sup>8</sup>he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross (Phil. 2:5-8 NLT).

<sup>9</sup>Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, <sup>10</sup>that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, <sup>11</sup>and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

- 1. Paul served with humility (2:16-18)
  - Paul spent his life for the Philippians ("poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice")

#### 2. <u>Timothy</u> served with humility (2:19-24)

- Timothy showed genuine interest for their welfare, not for his own interests
- 3. Epaphroditus served with humility (2:25-30)
  - Epaphroditus risked his life to serve Paul

**B.** Paul promises peace with God by following some simple commands (4:4-9).

<sup>4</sup>Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! <sup>5</sup>Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do. Remember, the Lord is coming soon.

<sup>6</sup>Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. <sup>7</sup>Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

#### **Philippians 4:4-7 NLT**

<sup>9</sup>Keep putting into practice all you learned and received from me—everything you heard from me and saw me doing. Then the God of peace will be with you.
