The Rapture

"And now, dear brothers and sisters, we want you to know what will happen to the believers who have died so you will not grieve like people who have no hope. ¹²For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus returns, God will bring back with him the believers who have died" (1 Thess. 4:13-14 NLT).

The Rapture

"For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God. First, the Christians who have died will rise from their graves. ¹⁷Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. Then we will be with the Lord forever. ¹⁸So encourage each other with these words" (1 Thess. 4:16-18 NLT).

How can you be prepared for the Rapture?

2 ways...

I. Serve Jesus without greed (1 Thess 1–3).



1 Thessalonians 1

Silas and Timothy (co-laborers in Thessalonica) wrote with Paul, who did not note his apostleship to show his concern (1:1).

"This letter is from Paul, Silas, and Timothy. We are writing to the church in Thessalonica, to you who belong to God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. May God give you grace and peace" (1:1 NLT).

Paul commended their lifestyle of godly living...



in view of Christ's return (1:2-10).

Paul's Advice to Troubled Thessalonians: Focus on God!

1 Thessalonians 2

Paul was not motivated by greed since he made tents and cared for them (2:1-16).

"Don't you remember, dear brothers and sisters, how hard we worked among you? Night and day we toiled to earn a living so that we would not be a burden to any of you as we preached God's Good News to you" (2:9 NLT).

I'm so proud of them! I must write to encourage them!

How can we **Strengthen** others?

This epistle was written in AD 51



How can we **strengthen** others?



Go in person (2:17-20).

Paul Tried to Go in Person

But, brothers, when we were torn away from you for a short time (in person, not in thought), out of our intense longing we made every effort to see you. ¹⁸For we wanted to come to you—certainly I, Paul, did, again and again—but Satan stopped us" (1 Thess 2:17-18 NIV)

Paul's greatest blessing = People!

"For what is our hope, our joy, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of our Lord Jesus when he comes? Is it not **YOU**? ²⁰Indeed, **YOU** are our glory and joy" (1 Thess 2:19-20 NIV)

The best way to show people how valuable they are is in person

How can we **strengthen** others?



Go in person (2:17-20).

1 Thessalonians 3
Bring others into their lives (3:1-9).



Paul sent Timothy to strengthen the church (3:1-5)

So when we could stand it no longer, we thought it best to be left by ourselves in Athens. ²We sent Timothy, who is our brother and God's fellow worker in spreading the gospel of Christ, to strengthen and encourage you in your faith, ³so that no one would be unsettled by these trials. You know quite well that we were destined for them.

Paul sent Timothy to strengthen the church (3:1-5)

⁴In fact, when we were with you, we kept telling you that we would be persecuted. And it turned out that way, as you well know. ⁵For this reason, when I could stand it no longer, I sent to find out about your faith. I was afraid that in some way the tempter might have tempted you and our efforts might have been useless.

Paul was encouraged (3:6-9)

⁶But Timothy has just now come to us from you and has brought good news about your faith and love. He has told us that you always have pleasant memories of us and that you long to see us, just as we also long to see you. ⁷Therefore, brothers, in all our distress and persecution we were encouraged about you because of your faith. ⁸For now we really live, since you are standing firm in the Lord. ⁹How can we thank God enough for you in return for all the joy we have in the presence of our God because of you?



Send others when you can't go

Bring others into their lives (3:1-9).

- A. Minister with others as peers (3:1-2a).
- B. Minister as a partner with God (3:2b).
- C. Minister as an <u>encourager</u> during other's trials (3:2c-4).
- D. Minister face-to-face in person (3:5).
- E. Send <u>others</u> when you can't go in person (3:6-9).

Pray for them (3:10-13).



¹¹ Now may our God and Father himself and our Lord Jesus clear the way for us to come to you.

Pray for them (3:10-13).

¹² May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you. ¹³ May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones.

Main Idea of 1 Thess 2:17–3:13 Strengthen others to show you care for them

How?

Visits: Go in person (2:17-20)
Co-laborers: Bring others (3:1-9)
Prayer: Pray for them (3:10-13)

What's Most Important?

Preparing for the Rapture

Although Paul appeared to be writing about and addressing 5 different issues in his letter, there is one topic which he repeatedly mentions: the Rapture.

--> Exhortations on the Rapture of believers to meet the Lord as end markers ending each chapter:

1:10 - "...and to wait for his Son from heaven..."
2:19 - "...in the presence of our Lord Jesus when he comes..."
3:13 - "...when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones."
4:16-18 - "...we who are still alive and are left will be caught up with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air..."
5:23 - "...at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Why should we look forward to the Rapture with expectancy?

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

3 Reasons

1. The Rapture helps us grieve with

hope (1 Thess 4:13-14).

"And now, dear brothers and sisters, we want you to know what will happen to the believers who have died..." (4:13a NLT).



Know about the future destiny of believers who die (4:13a).



Grief is hard

"Grief is the price we pay for love." *Queen Elizabeth II*





Being informed about believers who have died will prevent us from hopeless grief (4:13b).

"And now, dear brothers and sisters, we want you to know what will happen to the believers who have died so you will not grieve like people who have no hope" (4:13 NLT).

Five Stages of Grief



Time

The Rapture





Christ's resurrection guarantees the believer's resurrection (4:14).

"For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus returns, God will bring back with him the **believers** who have died" (4:14 NLT).

The Implictions



1. The Rapture helps us grieve with

hope (1 Thess 4:13-14).

2. Christians who have died will meet Christ in the air before those living (4:15-17).

"We tell you this directly from the Lord: We who are still living when the Lord returns will not meet him ahead of those who have died" (1 Thess 4:15 NLT).



Some future day 4 amazing events will happen without a moment's notice (4:16-17)

Return

"For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God" (1 Thess 4:16a NLT).

Resurrection

"First, the Christians who have died will rise from their graves" (1 Thess 4:16b NLT). "The dead in Christ will rise first" (1 Thess. 4:16b)

Why should we look forward to the Rapture with expectancy?



The Rapture gives hope and encouragement that he will come for you.

We will join him in the clouds

1 Thessalonians 5



After the Rapture...



comes the Tribulation...

"Now concerning how and when all this will happen, dear brothers and sisters, we don't really need to write you. ²For you know quite well that the day of the Lord's return will come unexpectedly, like a thief in the night."



"³When people are saying, 'Everything is peaceful and secure,' then disaster will fall on them as suddenly as a pregnant woman's labor pains begin. And there will be no escape" (1 Thess 5:1-3 NLT).

"But you aren't in the dark about these things, dear brothers and sisters, and you won't be surprised when the day of the Lord comes like a thief. ⁵For you are all children of the light and of the day; we don't belong to darkness and night. ⁶So be on your guard, not asleep like the others. Stay alert and be clearheaded" (1 Thess 5:4-6 NLT).
