### **Obey** God's Word

2 Timothy 1–2

## 2 Timothy 1

#### Paul greeted Timothy with his own persevering attitude in the face of death (1:1-2).



"I am writing to Timothy, my dear son. May God the **Father and Christ** Jesus our Lord give you grace, mercy, **Wand peace**" (2 Timothy 1:2 NLT).

#### Timothy should imitate others' faithfulness despite many who fell away (1:3-18).
#### He learned faithfulness from his mother and grandmother shown at his ordination (1:3-7).

#### 2 Timothy MAJOR THEME 1: Faithfulness

**Examples of Faithfulness:** 

a. Learned from mother Eunice & grandmother Lois (1:3-7)

Timothy learned in his own mixed-parentage home, with the women in his life setting the example of faithfulness in daily dealings.



#### 2 Timothy MAJOR THEME 1: Faithfulness



b. Learned from Paul (1:8-14)

> Paul remained faithful in difficult times because he believed and trusted God to keep him till the end (1:11-12).

#### He should bravely suffer Nero's tortures like Paul through the gospel's power (1:8-14).

"So never be ashamed to tell others about our Lord. And don't be ashamed of me, either, even though I'm in prison for him. With the strength God gives you, be ready to suffer with me for the sake of the Good News. <sup>9</sup> For God saved us and called us to live a holy life. He did this, not because we deserved it, but because that was his plan from before the beginning of time—to show us his grace through Christ Jesus" (2 Timothy 1:8-9 NLT).

"That is why I am suffering here in prison. But I am not ashamed of it, for I know the one in whom I trust, and I am sure that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until the day of his return" (2 Timothy 1:12 NLT).

#### Asian believers deserted Jesus but Onesiphorus set a faithful example (1:15-18).

#### Second Roman Imprisonment (AD 67-68) "As you know, everyone from the province of Asia has deserted me—even Phygelus and Hermogenes" (2 Tim. 1:15 NLT)

c. Learned from Onesiphorus (1:15-18)

Onesiphorus was not ashamed to be known as a friend of Paul when he was a prisoner. He searched for Paul very diligently and found him.

## 2 Timothy 2

#### Knowing what faithfulness looks like helps us persevere under trial (2 Tim 2).

#### Like a discipling teacher, invest in others the teaching you received (2:1-2).

#### **Multiply Yourself into Trustworthy Men!**



"You have heard me teach things that have been confirmed by many reliable witnesses. Now teach these truths to other trustworthy people who will be able to pass them on to others" (2 Tim. 2:2 NLT).

#### Like a successful athlete, obey the rules in God's Word (2:5).

Faithfulness = loyal to Christ, our commander, to follow the law of God and work hard

#### 2 Timothy 2:11–13 (NIV)

## 2 Timothy 3

Before Jesus returns, avoid false teachers who are smoothtongued but godless (3:1-9).

# Avoidgodlessgodlessteachers(3:1-9),

"You should know this, Timothy, that in the last days there will be very difficult times" (3:1 NLT).

#### 2 Timothy 19 Traits of Apostates (3:1-5)

lovers of themselves lovers of money boastful proud abusive without self-control disobedient to their parents ungrateful unholy without love

not lovers of the good treacherous rash conceited lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God having a form of godliness but denying its power

unforgiving

slanderous

brutal

"Avoid such men as these" (2 Timothy 3:5b NAU). "Stay away from people like that!" (2 Timothy 3:5b NLT). **Avoid godless leaders** 

"They are the kind who work [lit. creep] their way into people's homes and win the confidence of vulnerable women who are burdened with the guilt of sin and controlled by various desires. <sup>7</sup>(Such women are forever following new teachings, but they are never able to understand the truth.)" (2 Timothy 3:6-7 NLT).

#### **People-Pleasing Preaching**



**"These teachers oppose** the truth just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses. They have depraved minds and a counterfeit faith. <sup>9</sup>But they won't get away with this for long. Someday everyone will recognize what fools they are, just as with Jannes and Jambres" (3:8-9 NLT).


### Accept and preach the Word of God as well as fulfill all ministry duties (3:10–4:5).

### Accept truth (3:10-17).



### a. Follow God's servants (3:10-13)



"But you, Timothy, certainly know what I teach, and how I live, and what my purpose in life is. You know my faith, my patience, my love, and my endurance. <sup>11</sup>You know how much persecution and suffering I have endured. You know all about how I was persecuted in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra—but the Lord rescued me from all of it" (2 Timothy 3:10-11 NLT).

### Preach and live the truth by hardship, rebuking, encouraging, and evangelizing (4:1-5).

"I solemnly urge you in the presence of God and Christ Jesus, who will someday judge the living and the dead when he appears to set up his Kingdom: <sup>2</sup>Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching" (2 Timothy 4:1-2 NLT).

"For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. <sup>4</sup> They will reject the truth and chase after myths" (2 Timothy 4:3-4 NLT).

"But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out the ministry God has given you" (2 Timothy 4:5 NLT).

## Hope in God until death despite betrayals by friends (4:6-18).



"And now the prize awaits me—the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of his return. And the prize is not just for me but for all who eagerly look forward to his appearing" (2 Timothy 4:8 NLT).

### Do not be conquered by death, but victorious in it and relational through every trial (4:19-22).
