#### **Origin/Destination**

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General Epistles + Key Words

John's letter has at least five stated purposes: 1. to promote fellowship (1:3), Argument 2. to produce joy (1:4), 3. to protect holiness (2:1), 4. to prevent heresy (2:26), and 5. to provide assurance of salvation (5:13)



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- > This makes 1 John hard to sum up in one theme or purpose and difficult to outline, especially since the subjects overlap.
- But the general theme of obedience, especially shown by loving others, sums up all of the above purposes.
- These benefits are many, but the immediate benefit of obedience by love is its protection from early Gnosticism.

### I. Obey God's commands (1 John 1–2).

# Believe in Christ's humanity for fellowship and joy (1:1-4).



"We proclaim to you the one who existed from the beginning, whom we have heard and seen. We saw him with our own eyes and touched him with our own hands. He is the Word of life" (1 John 1:1 NLT).

Gnostics Taught a "Secret Knowledge" *Two Types Addressed in 1 John* 

**Docetic Gnosticism** From *dokeo*, "to seem" (Christ only *seemed* to be a man) Matter is Evil **Depreciated Materialism Denied Christ's Humanity Touched Jesus (1:1)** Led to Asceticism **Immorality exalted** 

**Cerinthian Gnosticism** From Cerinthus, founder in Asia (Christ only seemed to be God) Spirit is Good Exalted Knowledge (gnosis) **Denied Christ's Deity** Water & Blood (5:6) Led to Pride **Education exalted** 

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"This one who is life itself was revealed to us, and we have seen him. And now we testify and proclaim to you that he is the one who is eternal life. He was with the Father, and then he was revealed to us" (1 John 1:2 NLT).

"We proclaim to you what we ourselves have actually seen and heard so that you may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. <sup>4</sup>We are writing these things so that you may fully share our joy" (1 John 1:3-4 NLT).

#### John taught that God showcased Jesus

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God did the same thing when He sent Jesus Christ into the world. That's when the Word of Life was moved from behind the counters, out of the drawers and placed in a display case for all the world to see, handle and admire.

"That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us" (1 John 1:1-2).

<sup>7</sup> But if we are living in the light, as God is in the light, then we have fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses us from all sin" (1 John 1:6-7 NLT).

"If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth" (1 John 1:8 NLT).

"If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts" (1 John 1:10 NLT).

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Christ's Sacrifice = The Basis for Confession of Sin (sin is forgiven to restore fellowship but relationship has never been never threatened)

"My dear children, I am writing this to you so that you will not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous" (1 John 2:1 NLT). "Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us."

**Deception** (2:18-29)

"Dear children, the last hour is here. You have heard that the Antichrist is coming, and already many such antichrists have appeared. From this we know that the last hour has come. <sup>19</sup> These people left our churches, but they never really belonged with us; otherwise they would have stayed with us. When they left, it proved that they did not belong with us" (1 John 2:18-19 NLT).



## The Anointing of the Spirit

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"But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and all of you know the truth...<sup>27</sup>As for you, the anointing you received from him remains in you, and you do not need anyone to teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about all things and as that anointing is real, not counterfeit—just as it has taught you, remain in him" (1 John 2:20, 27)

## **Ryrie on the Anointing**

**YV** 

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"The difference between the anointing and indwelling seems to lie in their distinct purposes. The indwelling brings the presence of God into the life of the believer. The anointing, as far as the believer is concerned, is that he might be taught (1 John 2:20, 27). Actually, this seems to be the only purpose specified in the believer's case.



John's Key Purpose in Writing "I am writing these things to you about those who are trying to lead you astray... And now, dear children, continue in him, so that when he appears we may be confident and unashamed before him at his coming" (1 John 2:26, 28).

## How much can a believer sin (1 John 3:4)?

### NLT (cf. NIV)

"Everyone who sins is breaking God's law, for all sin is contrary to the law of God."

Absolute

NAU (cf. NET)

"Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness." Both translations are possible in the Greek text.

However, wouldn't it be lawless to sin even once?

Habitual

## How much can a believer sin (1 John 3:6)?

#### NLT (cf. NIV)

"Anyone who continues to live in him will not sin. But anyone who keeps on sinning does not know him or understand who he is."

### Habitual

### NAU (cf. NET)

"No one who abides in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or knows Him."

#### Absolute

Each of the preceding four translations are inconsistent in rendering verses 4 and 6.

But NLT, NAU, and NET all give the habitual sense to verse 6—all but the NIV, that reads, "He who does what is sinful is of the devil..."

> BOTTOM LINE: We sin when we follow Satan rather than God!

### Hatred of people is from Satan.

**"DARKNESS** cannot drive out DARKNESS only light can do that. cannot drive out only love can do that." Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

"We know what real love is because Jesus gave up his life for us. So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters. <sup>17</sup> If someone has enough money to live well and sees a brother or sister in need but shows no compassion—how can God's love be in that person?" (1 John 3:16-17 NLT).

"Dear children, let's not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions. <sup>19</sup> Our actions will show that we belong to the truth, so we will be confident when we stand before God. <sup>20</sup> Even if we feel guilty, God is greater than our feelings, and he knows everything" (1 John 3:18-20 NLT).

"Dear friends, do not believe everyone who claims to speak by the Spirit. You must test them to see if the spirit they have comes from God. For there are many false prophets in the world. <sup>2</sup>This is how we know if they have the Spirit of God: If a person claiming to be a prophet acknowledges that Jesus Christ came in a real body, that person has the Spirit of God" (1 John 4:1-2 NLT).
"But if someone claims to be a prophet and does not acknowledge the truth about Jesus, that person is not from God. Such a person has the spirit of the Antichrist, which you heard is coming into the world and indeed is already here" (1 John 4:3 NLT).

"But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over those people, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world. <sup>5</sup> Those people belong to this world, so they speak from the world's viewpoint, and the world listens to them" (1 John 4:4-5 NLT).

"But we belong to God, and those who know God listen to us. If they do not belong to God, they do not listen to us. That is how we know if someone has the Spirit of truth or the spirit of deception" (1 John 4:6 NLT).

I am not saying that he should pray about that. <sup>17</sup>All wrongdoing is sin, and there is sin that does not lead to death."
