#### Key Verse

"...Contend for the faith that was once for all entrusted to the saints. For certain men whose condemnation was written about long ago have secretly slipped in among you. They are godless men, who change the grace of our God into a license for immorality and deny Jesus Christ our only Sovereign and Lord" (Jude 3b-4).

#### Authorship

External Evidence > Despite its small size and limited subject matter, Jude was accepted as authentic and quoted by the early Church Fathers, including Tertullian and Origen.

It was also included in the Muratorian Canon (ca. AD 170).

#### Internal Evidence

This is the only NT letter of Jude, the half-brother of Jesus Christ & son of Joseph and Mary.

 Jude was therefore the brother of James (v. 1a), who also was a half brother of the Lord (Matt.
 13:55; Mark 6:3), the leader of the church at Jerusalem (Acts 15:13) and author of the epistle bearing his name (James 1:1).

Jude is the same as Judah or Judas and means "praise" (cf. Rom. 2:29).

"Dear friends, I had been eagerly planning to write to you about the salvation we all share. But now I find that I must write about something else, urging you to defend the faith that God has entrusted once for all time to his holy people" (Jude 3 NLT).

### Who are Pretenders Today?

"...some ungodly people have wormed their way into your churches, saying that God's marvelous grace allows us to live immoral lives. The condemnation of such people was recorded long ago, for they have denied our only Master and Lord, Jesus Christ" (Jude 4 NLT).

Are pretenders Christians?

No, as they are condemned, unlike believers (cf. Rom 8:1)
They are like demons in everlasting chains (v. 6)
They are like Sodomites who suffer eternal fire (v. 7)
They are reserved for "blackest darkness" (v. 13)
They "do not have the Spirit" (v. 18) while all believers do have the Spirit (Rom 8:9b)

## Three OT Examples of Pretenders (Jude 5-7)

"So I want to remind you, though you already know these things, that Jesus first rescued the nation of Israel from Egypt, but later he destroyed those who did not remain faithful" (Jude 5 NLT).





"So the Lord sent poisonous snakes among the people, and many were bitten and died. <sup>7</sup>Then the people came to Moses and cried out, 'We have sinned by speaking against the Lord and against you. Pray that the Lord will take away the snakes.' So Moses prayed for the people" (Numbers 21:6-7 NLT).



#### **Issues in Jude**

### The Angels

**And I remind you of the angels** who did not stay within the limits of authority God gave them but left the place where they belonged. God has kept them securely chained in prisons of darkness, waiting for the great day of judgment" (Jude 6 NLT).


"And don't forget Sodom and Gomorrah and their neighboring towns, which were filled with immorality and every kind of sexual perversion.

Those cities were destroyed by fire and serve as a warning of the eternal fire of God's judgment" (Jude 7 NLT).

# The Behavior of Pretenders (Jude 8-13)

"In the same way, these people—who claim authority from their dreams—live immoral lives, defy authority, and scoff at supernatural beings" (Jude 8 NLT).

#### Why is a Quote from Non-Scriptural Writings a Problem?

Jude does not imply that the entire 1 Enoch is inspired.

"These people are grumblers and complainers, living only to satisfy their desires. They brag loudly about themselves, and they flatter others to get what they want" (Jude 16 NLT).

III. Jude shows three ways how to avoid the pretenders' snares to safeguard his readers from apostasy (17-23).

#### Remember 17-19 Diagonal Show mercy 22-23



"But you, my dear friends, must remember what the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ said. <sup>18</sup>They told you that in the last times there would be scoffers whose purpose in life is to satisfy their ungodly desires. <sup>19</sup>These people are the ones who are creating divisions among you. They follow their natural instincts because they do not have God's Spirit in them" (Jude 17-19 NLT).



"But you, dear friends, must build each other up in your most holy faith, pray in the power of the Holy Spirit, <sup>21</sup>and await the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ, who will bring you eternal life. In this way, you will keep yourselves safe in God's love" (Jude 20-21 NLT).

"And you must show mercy to those whose faith is wavering. <sup>23</sup>Rescue others by snatching them from the flames of judgment. Show mercy to still others, but do so with great caution, hating the sins that contaminate their lives" (Jude 22-23 NLT).

On the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Instead of salvation by "special knowledge" (*gnosis*) for only a special few, all saints in the universal ("catholic") church hold these truths. 153e

We don't need *enlightenment* from our *ignorance*. We need *forgiveness* of our *sins*.

the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

Not just our *spirits* will join God after death. Heaven is a physical place where we will *physically* dwell with God for eternity.
