Learning biblical Hebrew can be a bit daunting. Convinced of the importance of studying the original text of the Old Testament, many students tackle the language with excitement and hope, only to get discouraged and give up. This need not happen. David Brewer, who has taught Hebrew for over thirty years, has devised an online Hebrew class that seeks to make learning the language enjoyable with the goal of producing a positive outcome. David rightly understands that reading Hebrew via a formal grammar is not enough. Hearing and speaking the language are also vital to learning it. To that end, David incorporates singing and extra-biblical reading into his lessons, including Hebrew comic books and Tall Tales. These methods facilitate vocabulary retention through repetition. In many Hebrew classes, students do not look at the Hebrew text until well into the course. However, David employs an inductive classroom method that engages the text almost immediately and fuels the student's motivation to learn the language. This inductive, interactive approach supplements nicely the formal study of the grammar through the course textbook. If you want to learn biblical Hebrew in an engaging, enjoyable, effective way, I recommend that you consider taking David's course.

Dear Friends,

I have known David Brewer as a colleague and friend for many years. We share a common love for the Hebrew text of the Bible and endeavor to share that love with anyone who would set their hand to the task of acquiring skill in handling the Bible in the original languages, especially the Hebrew text.

There are many methods of acquiring such skills most of which revolve around the memorization of rules, vocabulary, syntax, and observation. David has spent much of his adult life seeking a better way to impart such truth and material to the individual who is new to the task.

Simply put, he has combined the "best" of the normal classroom methodology with an experiential approach to language that mimics the way we learned our "Mother Tongue." That is, trial and error, hearing and understanding patterns before the grammatical definitions are introduced. If you can't remember your own experience watch the little ones as they first learn by hearing, then speaking, then to read and write, and then to gradually acquire the grammatical definitions and rules of what they already understand intuitively.

In my opinion David's methodology is far superior to the rote methodologies employed in most classrooms. The acquisition of such skills should be enjoyable as well as challenging. He will lead you through a series of experiences that meet the criteria described and allow you to learn and retain what you learned in the most efficient and enjoyable way possible – in many respects, the way you learned your mother tongue.
