

The Transfiguration of Jesus

Mark 9:2-13

- I. (v2-6) Terrified in the presence of the Lord.
 - A. Limited group in a remote location
 - B. Jesus was supernaturally transformed
 - C. Peter's response shows his fear

*When in the presence of the glorified Lord, our sin makes us afraid.
How can we overcome that fear?*

- II. (v7-8) Listen to the Lord!
 - A. Jesus called beloved son, same as at his baptism
 - B. God gives command to listen to Jesus.

What does following God's command look like?

- III. (v9-10) The disciples listened to the Lord!

What if I don't understand something?

- IV. (v.11-13) Disciples questions are answered by the Lord.

*Jesus affirmed the authority of the Old Testament Scriptures
and then stated they pointed to him.*

Be Transformed, not Terrified

The transfiguration of our Lord admonishes us of a change which we are to undergo in this life. We must be conformed in our souls and spirits, and the use of our bodies, to the image of the Son of God (Rom. 8:29)
