



\* The Greek texts vary considerably from the Ethiopic text here. One Greek manuscript adds to this section, "And they [the women] bore to them [the Watchers] three races: First, the great giants. The giants brought forth [some say "slew"] the Naphelim, and the Naphelim brought forth [or "slew"] the Elioud. And they existed, increasing in power according to their greatness." See the account in the Book of Jubilees.

<sup>3</sup>These (giants) consumed the produce of all the people until the people detested feeding them.

<sup>4</sup>So the giants turned against (the people) in order to eat them.



<sup>5</sup>And they began to sin against birds, wild beasts, reptiles, and fish. And their flesh was devoured the one by the other,\* and they drank blood.

<sup>6</sup>And then the earth brought an accusation against the oppressors.

\* Or, "one another's flesh." R.H. Charles notes that this phrase may refer to the destruction of one class of giants by another (Charles, 65).

#### Criticism of "Noah"

Ken Ham (Answers in Genesis): "Except for some of the names...hardly any remnant of the Bible's account of the flood in Genesis 6–9 is recognizable in the movie. Yes, there is an ark in the film that is true to the massive biblical proportions, but it did not look seaworthy. There were many animals that came to Noah and went aboard the ark, but there were far too many creatures crammed inside, certainly many more than were needed."

#### Criticism of "Noah"

Ken Ham (Answers in Genesis): "Also, while the extreme wickedness of man was depicted, the real sin displayed in the film was the people's destruction of the earth. Lost within the film's extreme environmentalist message is that the actual sins of the preflood people were rebellion against God and man's inhumanity to man."



#### Criticism of "Noah"

Ken Ham (Answers in Genesis): "Ultimately, there is barely a hint of biblical fidelity in this film. It is an unbiblical, pagan film from its start. It opens, 'In the beginning there was nothing.' The Bible opens, 'In the beginning God.' That difference helps sum up the problem I have with the film. The Bible is about the true God of creation; the movie does not present the true God of the **Bible.**"







#### Support for the Angel View

- Phrase refers only to angels elsewhere (Job 1:6; 2:1; 38:7; cf. Ps. 29:1)
- Explains God and men contrast & overstepping natural bounds

- Oldest view (1 Enoch, etc.)
  - NT support (2 Pet. 2:4; Jude 6-7)
  - Explains power of Nephilim offspring



## Critiquing the Angel View

- "God" can denote human judges (Ps. 82:1, 6-7)
   —but not "sons of God"
- "At the resurrection people will neither marry nor be given in marriage; they will be like the angels in heaven" (Matt. 22:30)
  - —but does future celibacy imply past celibacy?

- Punishing humans for the sin of angels seems unfair
  - —but Jude 6 says some angels are bound
- NT support debatable
- Mythological tone
- Angels not in context

## **Godly Line of Seth View**



- Elohim ("God") does at times refer to men
- Worldly Cainites contrast with Godly Sethites in Gen. 4
- The line of blessing was to be kept pure
- Luther & Calvin supported this view

## But...

- This is not the normal usage
- "Daughters of men" is general and without an evil sense
- No evidence shows these lines separate
- Their support is late and irrelevant
- Men in v. 1 must align with men in v. 2

# The Dynasty-Ruler View Problems

- *Elohim* ("God") at times denotes judges (Exod. 21:6; 22:8-9, 28; Ps. 82:1, 6-7)
- God-king relationship noted as "father" to "son" (2 Sam. 7:14)
- True, but judges are not in the context so "sons of God" as angels is better
- True, but Gen. 6 says nothing about kings
- A group of kings is never called "sons of God" in OT or ANE

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
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### Noah's Ark Size



'May Canaan be cursed! May he be the lowest of servants to his relatives'" (9:24-25 NLT).







"The Genesis Flood may well have extended beyond Mesopotamia. Most of the place names recorded in Genesis 2–8 are associated with locations within Mesopotamia, but some are not. The notable exceptions are the Pishon and Gihon rivers, which flowed from the southern part of the Arabian Peninsula. It seems possible that the Genesis Flood inundated not only all of Mesopotamia but also the entire Persian Gulf region and much of southern Arabia as well."

# How high was the water?

<sup>18</sup> The waters rose and increased greatly on the earth, and the ark floated on the surface of the water. <sup>19</sup> They rose greatly on the earth, and all the high mountains under the entire heavens were covered. <sup>20</sup> The waters rose and covered the mountains to a depth of more than twenty feet (Gen. 7:18-20).

# But why not a local flood?

• If the Flood was local, people who did not happen to be living in the vicinity would not be affected by it. They would have escaped God's judgment on sin. If this had happened, what did Christ mean when He likened the coming judgment of all men to the judgment of "all" men in the days of Noah (Matthew 24:37–39)? A partial judgment in Noah's day means a partial judgment to come.



## Rodinia—The World That Perished The transformation of Adam's

world into today's world

In Genesis 6–8 we read of a catastrophe that impacted the earth in a way unlike any other disaster since that time. Such a catastrophe would impact not only the earth's atmosphere and inhabitants but also its very foundations. The earth's landmass during Adam's day was extremely different from the seven continents of our modern world. But what caused it to change so drastically? Catastrophic plate tectonics (CPT) is one possible contributing factor.

#### **Flood Period**

The worldwide Flood covered the entire globe-over the highest mountains of that day by more than 15 cubits (up to 26 ft [8m]) (Genesis 7:20).

#### Rodinia

Most secular and biblical geologists believe that all the land has been together more than once. One of these supercontinents is called "Rodinia" (from the Russian word for "motherland"). Although scientists continue to debate its exact shape, when God spoke the dry land into existence on Day 3 of Creation Week (Genesis 1:9-10), He may have created a landmass similar to Rodinia

"fountains of the great deep" and an opening of the "windows of heaven" (Genesis 7:11; see below). This may have been the result of the breakup of the original supercontinent into huge plates of the earth's crust. These plates split, moved, and collided throughout the duration of the Flood.

#### Pangaea

that, after the breakup, the land again smashed together, forming another supercontinent called Pangaea. This temporary supercontinent formed and broke up entirely during the Flood.

#### Transitional Period

Still during the flood, Pangaea broke apart, first into Laurasia and Gondwana and finally into the continents we have today. At the end of this period the Indian subcontinent slammed into the Eurasian plate, forming the Himalayan mountains.



#### Today's World

Today, we are left with evidence that the continents moved apart in the past. For example, the coastlines of South America and Africa fit together, like pieces of a puzzle.

Catastrophic plate movement also explains the fascinating magnetic pattern found in ocean floor rocks. These rocks record a "zebra stripe" pattern of magnetic pole reversals. switching back and forth between north and south (see below).

## **Dinosaurs Lived Recently**

 Behemoth--giant vegetarian (Job 40:15-24)



- Leviathan--ferocious meat eater (Job 41)
- British King Morvidus was killed by a monster by being "gulped down... as a big fish swallows a little one" (336 BC)
- A monster was killed in 1693 in Bedd-yr-Afanc, England
- Monsters have been reported in nearly 200 places in England alone

# Beowulf & the Creatures of Denmark

- Danish poem extols Beowulf (AD 495-583)--later king for 50 years
- The monster Grendel ("grinder, destroyer") preyed on Danes 12 years (AD 503-515)
- This hero cleared monstrous animals from the sea lanes between Denmark and Sweden
- He then pulled out Grendel's small arm, who retreated to his cave and bled to death

## Japanese Fisherman's Dead Monster (*The Times* 21 July 1977)

- Two tons & ten meters long
- Caught at 330 meters deep ocean near Christchurch
- Plesiosaurus: huge, small-headed reptiles with long neck and four fins
- Photographed and sketched by marine biologist Michihiko Yano
- Captain threw it back into sea for fear of contaminating his fish.
- Soon after BBC reported it to be a shark (30 July 1977)!




Figure 10.1 The drawing and measurements made by Michihiko Yano of the creature's skeleton that was dredged up off the New Zealand coast in 1977, and which the BBC and British Museum of Natural History would assure us was the body of a dead shark.


