Is God Concerned for Social Justice?

"The LORD is a God of social justice." That's the message in maybe most churches and synagogues in America and the West today. But here's the problem. The Bible doesn't actually say that. It says in Isaiah, "The LORD [is a God of] justice" [Isa 5:16]. You'll find a lot of references to justice in the Bible. But you'll never find it preceded by the word "social." But you're probably thinking, "What's the difference? Isn't God the God of justice <u>and</u> social justice?" Well, not if he is consistent.

You see, God cannot be the God of "justice" and "social justice" because social justice is not just.

Justice is getting what you deserve without favor.

Social justice is getting what you don't deserve because you <u>are</u> favored.

Justice is blind.

Social justice is not.


- Micah 5:2 is the only OT prophecy that predicts the birthplace of the Messiah as Bethlehem.
- Micah also gives the best descriptions of the righteous reign of Christ over the whole world (2:12-13; 4:1-8; 5:4-5).



- Literary criticism by Ewald in 1867
- Redaction criticism Micah's final form claimed to be a process of growth over time -Mays, Willi Plein (1971), van der Woude, Renaud (1977) and Wolff.
- Willis (1969) found three sections beginning with the imperative "hear" at 1:2; 3:1 and 6:1 and each having a threat of judgment followed by a promise of salvation.


