
Day of the LORD

## **Key Verse**

"Gather together...before the day of the LORD's wrath comes upon you. Seek the LORD, all you humble of the land, you who do what he commands. Seek righteousness, seek humility; perhaps you will be sheltered on the day of the LORD's anger" (2:1-3).

## Kingdom Statement

Judah should repent because of a future day of judgment (1:1–3:8) and blessing (3:9-20) on the whole earth caused by God as King.



## **Summary Statement**

The day of the LORD judgment upon Judah, the surrounding nations, and the entire earth warns Judah to repent due to God's righteousness and his promise of a remnant in a national restoration.

#### Covenant


After discipline of Jerusalem (3:1-7) and the nations (2:4-15; 3:8), Israel will be restored and prosper in fulfillment of the land and new covenants (3:19-20).

#### Redemption

The "day of the LORD" is not only retribution (1:14; etc.) but salvation and restoration as well (2:7; 3:17, 20).

#### Messiah

Jesus referred to his second advent as a sweeping away of the wicked (1:3 in Matt. 13:41) and a time of distress for Israel (1:15 in Matt. 24:21).

# II. God's future deliverance encourages us to hope.



## Main Idea

Be hopeful yet repentant.





## Application

1. God's wrath against evildoers should warn us who have turned away.

While God is compassionate and loving, He is also a God of justice and holiness.

In similar times of national calamity today, divine discipline should rouse the indifferent and purify the good.

#### 2. God's People as a Sacrifice to Him.

Sacrifice was well understood in Jerusalem. Offerings were made to the one true God, and when the people rebelled against God or had become corrupt, they also offered to the idols.


But now YHWH declared through Zephaniah that the faithless, corrupt and indifferent people should themselves be sacrificed (1:7-8).

We also must examine our lives. We easily quote Romans 12:1-2, "...offering ourselves as a living sacrifice...." but have we truly reckoned what it means to live our lives in holy reverence for the LORD – in purity as a living sacrifice to YHWH?

### **Historical Context**

- Zephaniah literally means "YHWH hides"
- Occasion: Reign of Josiah, Judean King
- Josiah => 16<sup>th</sup> King (640 609 вс)

Tried to bring a reform to restore the worship of YHWH

Zephaniah spoke! 630 BC

**Previous Kings** 


Manasseh and his son

They will plant vineyards but never drink wine from them" (Zephaniah 1:12-13 NLT).

Seek to do what is right and to live humbly. Perhaps even yet the LORD will protect you protect you from his anger on that day of destruction" (Zephaniah 2:1-3 NLT).









"Gaza and Ashkelon will be abandoned, Ashdod and Ekron torn down. <sup>5</sup>And what sorrow awaits you Philistines who live along the coast and in the land of Canaan, for this judgment is against you, too! The LORD will destroy you until not one of you is left. <sup>6</sup>The Philistine coast will become a wilderness pasture, a place of shepherd camps and enclosures for sheep and goats. <sup>7</sup>The remnant of the tribe of Judah will pasture there. They will rest at night in the abandoned houses in Ashkelon. For the LORD their God will visit his people in kindness and restore their prosperity again" (Zephaniah 2:4-7 NLT).



"I have heard the taunts of the Moabites and the insults of the Ammonites, mocking my people and invading their borders. <sup>9</sup>Now, as surely as I live,' says the LORD of Heaven's Armies, the God of Israel, 'Moab and Ammon will be destroyed destroyed as completely as Sodom and Gomorrah. Their land will become a place of stinging nettles, salt pits, and eternal desolation. The remnant of my people will plunder them and take their land" (Zephaniah 2:8-9 NLT).









"And the LORD will strike the lands of the north with his fist, destroying the land of Assyria. He will make its great capital, Nineveh, a desolate wasteland, parched like a desert. <sup>14</sup>The proud city will become a pasture for flocks and herds, and all sorts of wild animals will settle there. The desert owl and screech owl will roost on its ruined columns, their calls echoing through the gaping windows. Rubble will block all the doorways, and the cedar paneling will be exposed to the weather" (Zephaniah 2:13-14 NLT).

#### Nineveh's Water System Destroyed

- "And He will stretch out His hand against the north and destroy Assyria, and He will make Nineveh a desolation, parched like the wilderness" (Zeph. 2:13)
- The prophesied destruction of Nineveh (Zeph. 2:13), the capital of Assyria in what is now Iraq, fell in 612 BC into the hands of the neighboring Babylonians, with the whole empire taken by 605 BC. The prediction that God would leave Nineveh "dry as a desert" is remarkable in view of the fame of the city's great irrigation system.

- Theocratic: like confession of sin (1 John 1:9)

- Paul offered a temple sacrifice in AD 57 (Acts 21:26) without seeing a "digression problem"

Concept that appears in every prophetical writing in the OT In Zephaniah:

- The Day of YHWH is noted 23 times in 3 chapters
- Variations: "The Day of YHWH," "Day," etc.

#### "The Day" is

- -a. Imminent (1:14)
- -b. Day of terror (1:15)
- -c. Judgment for sins (1:17)
- -d. Universal judgment (1:2-3, 2:4-15; 3:8)
- -e. Great convulsion of nature (1:15)
- -f. Remnant redeemed (3:16-17)



Kingdom Teaching...

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Scripture has a dual kingdom-covenant theme. Israel's role from Abraham to Christ expands to include the Church (continuity) yet the Church never replaces the nation as the "new Israel" (discontinuity). Israel will enjoy world prominence after trusting Christ at His second coming.



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

## Keys

Key Verse: "Gather together...before the day of the LORD's wrath comes upon you. Seek the LORD, all you humble of the land, you who do what he commands. Seek righteousness, seek humility; perhaps you will be sheltered on the day of the LORD's anger" (Zeph. 2:1-3).

#### **Summary Statement:**

Zephaniah prophesies the day of the LORD judgment upon Judah, the surrounding nations, and the entire earth to exhort Judah to repent because of God's righteous character and His promise of a remnant in a national restoration.

#### **Application:**

If you insist on *living* like a pagan, then you will *die* like a pagan (Huang Sabin)

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## 4. God's Presence

#### **Centrality of God's presence:**

- 1:1 opens with God's covenant name—YHWH
- 3:20 closes with YHWH

Chapters in between shows God's intervention into human history in a mighty transforming way (Judgment 1:1–3:8; Restoration/Salvation 3:9-20)



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## 5. Creation & 'Decreation'

God is present in the Creation:



1:1 - 3:8 Shows God's judgment upon His creation. God would not hesitate to bring about a period of 'decreating' or 'uncreating' (esp 1:3)

Judgment is severe.

YHWH's destruction "will be just as bleak as his creating was abundant" (Greg A. King)

It seems that the earth will return its initial stage of mess and formlessness and devoid of life (Gen. 1:2).

Order of creation reversed in Zephaniah

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## 6. Land in the eyes of the prophets

- Zephaniah confirmed the past teaching that continual occupancy of the land is tied to obedience. Land is a gift from God.
- After Judah and Israel were divided, prophecies were given against the people for their harlotry (running after other gods).
- During Josiah's reign: Baal was still worshipped, and high places were flourishing (1:4), hosts of heaven were adored upon the housetops (1:5) and multitudes had turned entirely from following YHWH (1:6).

#### Results of Manasseh's Evil Reign

6. Land in the eyes of the prophets (continued)

During Manasseh's evil 55-year reign:

People turned skeptical during his cruel rule; hearts turned indifferent towards God.

"YHWH will not do good, neither will he do evil" 1:12

- Religious leaders became misleaders (3:4)
- Though a remnant had turned back to God or remained faithful, this was insufficient to avert the awful judgment upon the nation (thankfully, though, these would be hidden in the day of YHWH's wrath).

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## 7. Faithfulness & righteousness of the remnant

- Their reward: Salvation from terror of the Day
- Their identity: those "righteous and ethical in their interaction with and treatment of others"



## Application

1. God's wrath against evildoers should warn us who have turned away

While God is compassionate and loving, He is also a God of justice and holiness.

In similar times of national calamity today, divine discipline should rouse the indifferent and purify the good.

#### 2. God's People as a Sacrifice to Him

Sacrifice was well understood in Jerusalem. Offerings were made to the one true God, and when the people rebelled against God or had become corrupt, they also offered to the idols.

But now YHWH declared through Zephaniah that the faithless, corrupt and indifferent people should themselves be sacrificed (1:7).

We also must examine our lives. We easily quote Romans 12:1-2, "...offering ourselves as a living sacrifice...." but have we truly reckoned what it means to live our lives in holy reverence for the LORD – in purity as a living sacrifice to YHWH?

## Conclusion


The minor prophets are by no means insignificant.

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
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
