## THESIS OF THE BOOK

In spite of Yahweh's great love for Israel, the postexilic community was dishonoring God's name through their disobedience to the Law (as well as the neglect of the sacrificial system by the Levitical priests).

## PURPOSE OF THE BOOK

To awaken the people from spiritual lethargy and unfaithfulness so as: (1) to avoid God's curses (discipline) and (2) to be prepared for the coming of the Lord and His messenger (He will reward the faithful and punish the wicked).
